Important - Read Carefully. Notice to User:

This End User License Agreement (“Software License Agreement”) is a legal agreement between you, the User, and Palstar Incorporated. **It is important that you read this document before using the Palstar-provided software (“Software”) that is pre-loaded into your AT-AUTO Antenna Tuner, and any accompanying documentation, including, without limitation printed materials, ‘online’ files, or electronic documentation (“Documentation”).** By powering on the AT-AUTO and or installing future updates to the AT-AUTO firmware via the Palstar website (www.palstar.com) you agree to be bound by the terms of the Palstar AT-AUTO Software License Agreement including, without limitation, the warranty disclaimers, and limitation of liability. You agree that this agreement is enforceable like any written agreement negotiated and signed by you. **If you do not agree, you are not licensed to use the Software, and you MAY NOT POWER UP OR USE THE AT-AUTO and must return the AT-AUTO to Palstar for a full refund of your purchase price.**

1. SOFTWARE LICENSE

(a) License Grant. Upon your acceptance of this Software License Agreement Palstar grants you a non-exclusive, non-transferable (except as provided below), limited license to use a copy of the Software on your AT-AUTO. You may not distribute or redistribute, sublicense, sell, or transfer to a third party the Restricted Source Code, unless said third party already has a license to the Restricted Source Code through their separate license agreement with PALSTAR or other agreement with PALSTAR. PALSTAR reserves all other rights in and to the Software. Reverse engineering, Section 1(h) of this agreement, specifies that the Software is strictly prohibited as further detailed therein.

(b) Upgrades and Updates. Software that is downloaded and installed as an upgrade or an update replaces all or part of the Software previously licensed. The update or upgrade and does not constitute the granting of a second license to the Software in that you may not use the upgrade or update in addition to the Software that it is replacing. You agree that use of the upgrade or update terminates your license to use the Software or portion thereof replaced.

(c) Title. Title to the Software is not transferred to you. Ownership of all copies of the Software is vested in Palstar, subject to the rights of use granted to you in this Software License Agreement.

(d) Reverse Engineering. You may not reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble or otherwise attempt to discover the source code, underlying ideas, underlying user interface techniques or algorithms of the Software by any means whatsoever, directly or indirectly, or disclose any of the foregoing. Palstar reserves the right to litigate to the full extent and authority any violations of this agreement evidencing reverse engineering under the jurisdiction of the applicable laws in the United States, European Union, and all other international and local laws. Discovery of any alleged violation will result in immediate legal action. Requests for information from users with respect to developing applications that access the Restricted Source Code of the AT-AUTO firmware should be directed to Palstar engineering.

(i) Other Restrictions. You may not loan, rent, lease, sublicense, distribute or otherwise transfer all or any portion of the Software to third parties except to the limited extent set forth in Section 3 or otherwise expressly provided. You may not copy the Software except as expressly set forth above, and any copies that you are permitted to make pursuant to this Software License Agreement must contain the same copyright, patent and other intellectual property markings that appear on or in the Software. You may not modify, adapt or translate the Software. You may not, directly or indirectly, encumber or suffer to exist any lien or security interest on the Software; knowingly take any action that would cause the Software to be placed in the public domain; or use the Software in any environment outside of its use as directly related to the function and purpose of the AT-AUTO. You will comply with applicable law and Palstar's instructions regarding the use of the Software. YOU AGREE THAT YOU ARE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACCURACY AND ADEQUACY OF THE SOFTWARE FOR YOUR INTENDED USE AND YOU WILL INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS PALSTAR FROM ANY 3RD PARTY SUIT TO THE EXTENT BASED UPON THE ACCURACY AND ADEQUACY OF THE SOFTWARE IN YOUR USE. WITHOUT LIMITATION, THE AT-AUTO AND ITS SOFTWARE IS NOT INTENDED FOR USE IN THE OPERATION OF NUCLEAR FACILITIES, AIRCRAFT NAVIGATION, COMMUNICATION SYSTEMS OR AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL EQUIPMENT, WHERE THE FAILURE OF THE SOFTWARE COULD LEAD TO DEATH, PERSONAL INJURY OR SEVERE PHYSICAL OR ENVIRONMENTAL DAMAGE.

2. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Acknowledgement of Palstar's Rights. You acknowledge that the Software is the intellectual property of and are owned by Palstar and its suppliers. The structure, organization and code of the Software are the valuable trade secrets and confidential information of Palstar and its suppliers. The Software is protected by copyright, including without limitation by United States Copyright Law, international treaty provisions and applicable laws in the country in which it is being used. You acknowledge that Palstar retains the ownership of all patents, copyrights, trade secrets, trademarks and other intellectual property rights pertaining to the Software, and all accompanying printed materials. You will take no actions which adversely affect Palstar's intellectual property rights in the Software. Trademarks shall be used in accordance with accepted trademark practice, including identification of trademark owners' names. Trademarks may only be used to identify printed output produced by the Software, and such use of any trademark does not give you any right of ownership in that trademark. Palstar and AT-AUTO are trademarks of Palstar Incorporated (registered in USA). Except as expressly stated above, this Software License Agreement does not grant you any intellectual property rights in the Software. 3. LIMITED TRANSFER RIGHTS

Notwithstanding the foregoing, you may transfer all your rights to use the Software to another person or legal entity provided that: (a) you also transfer each of this Software License Agreement, the Software and all other software or hardware bundled or pre-installed with the Software, including all copies, updates and prior versions to such person or entity; (b) you retain no copies, including backups and copies stored on a computer; and (c) the receiving party accepts the terms and conditions of this Software License Agreement and any other terms and conditions upon which you legally purchased a license to the Software.

4. PRE-RELEASE AND EVALUATION PRODUCT ADDITIONAL TERMS

If the product you have received with this license is pre-commercial release or beta Software ("Pre-release Software"), then this Section applies. In addition, this section applies to all evaluation and/or demonstration copies of Palstar software ("Evaluation Software") and continues in effect until you purchase a license. To the extent that any provision in this section is in conflict with any other term or condition in this Software License Agreement, this section shall supersede such other term(s) and condition(s) with respect to the Pre-release and/or Evaluation Software, but only to the extent necessary to resolve the conflict. You acknowledge that the Pre-release Software is a pre-release version, does not represent final product from Palstar, and may contain bugs, errors and other problems that could cause system or other failures and data loss.

5. LIMITED WARRANTY AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

(a) Limited Warranty and Customer Remedies. Palstar warrants to the person or entity that first purchases a license for use of the Software pursuant to the terms of this Software License Agreement that (i) the Software will perform substantially in accordance with any accompanying Documentation for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of receipt, and (ii) any support services provided by Palstar shall be substantially as described in Section 6 of this agreement. Some states and jurisdictions do not allow limitations on duration of an implied warranty, so the above limitation may not apply to you. To the extent allowed by applicable law, implied warranties on the Software, if any, are limited to ninety (90) days. Palstar's and its suppliers' entire liability and your exclusive remedy shall be, at Palstar's option, either (i) return of the price paid, if any, or (ii) repair or replacement of the Software that does not meet Palstar's Limited Warranty and which is returned to Palstar with a copy of your receipt. This Limited Warranty is void if failure of the Software has resulted from accident, abuse, misapplication, abnormal use, Trojan horse, virus, or any other malicious external code. Any replacement Software will be warranted for the remainder of the original warranty period or thirty (30) days, whichever is longer. This limited warranty does not apply to Evaluation and/or Pre-release Software.

(b) No Other Warranties and Disclaimer. THE FOREGOING LIMITED WARRANTY AND REMEDIES STATE THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDIES FOR PALSTAR OR ITS SUPPLIER'S BREACH OF WARRANTY. TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, PALSTAR AND ITS SUPPLIERS DISCLAIM ALL OTHER WARRANTIES AND CONDITIONS, EITHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, SATISFACTORY QUALITY, INFORMATIONAL CONTENT OR ACCURACY, QUIET ENJOYMENT, TITLE AND NON-INFRINGEMENT, WITH REGARD TO THE SOFTWARE, AND THE PROVISION OF OR FAILURE TO PROVIDE SUPPORT SERVICES. THIS LIMITED WARRANTY GIVES YOU SPECIFIC LEGAL RIGHTS. YOU MAY HAVE OTHERS, WHICH VARY FROM STATE/JURISDICTION TO STATE/JURISDICTION.

(c) Limitation Of Liability. TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW EVEN IF A REMEDY FAILS ITS ESSENTIAL PURPOSE, IN NO EVENT SHALL PALSTAR OR ITS SUPPLIERS BE LIABLE FOR ANY SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, DIRECT, INDIRECT OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES WHATSOEVER (INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, DAMAGES FOR LOSS

OF BUSINESS PROFITS, BUSINESS INTERRUPTION, LOSS OF BUSINESS INFORMATION, OR ANY OTHER PECUNIARY LOSS) ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF OR INABILITY TO USE THE SOFTWARE OR THE PROVISION OF OR FAILURE TO PROVIDE SUPPORT SERVICES, EVEN IF PALSTAR HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES. IN ANY CASE, PALSTAR'S ENTIRE LIABILITY UNDER ANY PROVISION OF THIS SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE AMOUNT ACTUALLY PAID BY YOU FOR THE SOFTWARE PRODUCT. Because some states and jurisdictions do not allow the exclusion or limitation of liability, the above limitation may not apply to you. In such states and jurisdictions, Palstar's liability shall be limited to the greatest extent permitted by law and the limitations or exclusions of warranties and liability contained herein do not prejudice applicable statutory consumer rights of person acquiring goods otherwise than in the course of business. The disclaimer and limited liability above are fundamental to this Software License Agreement between Palstar and you.

(d) Infringement Claims. Palstar will indemnify and hold you harmless and will defend or settle any claim, suit or proceeding brought against you by a third party that is based upon a claim that the content contained in the Software infringes a copyright or violates an intellectual or proprietary right protected by United States or European Union law ("Claim"), but only to the extent the Claim arises directly out of the use of the Software and subject to the limitations set forth in Section 5 of this Agreement except as otherwise expressly provided. You must notify Palstar in writing of any Claim within ten (10) business days after you first receive notice of the Claim, and you shall provide to Palstar at no cost with such assistance and cooperation as Palstar may reasonably request from time to time in connection with the defense of the Claim. Palstar shall have sole control over any Claim (including, without limitation, the selection of counsel and the right to settle on your behalf on any terms Palstar deems desirable in the sole exercise of its discretion). You may, at your sole cost, retain separate counsel and participate in the defense or settlement negotiations. Palstar shall pay actual damages, costs, and attorney fees awarded against you (or payable by you pursuant to a settlement agreement) in connection with a Claim to the extent such direct damages and costs are not reimbursed to you by insurance or a third party, to an aggregate maximum equal to the purchase price of the Software. If the Software or its use becomes the subject of a Claim or its use is enjoined, or if in the opinion of Palstar's legal counsel the Software is likely to become the subject of a Claim, Palstar shall attempt to resolve the Claim by using commercially reasonable efforts to modify the Software or obtain a license to continue using the Software. If in the opinion of Palstar's legal counsel the Claim, the injunction or potential Claim cannot be resolved through reasonable modification or licensing, Palstar, at its own election, may terminate this Software License Agreement without penalty, and will refund to you on a pro rata basis any fees paid in advance by you to Palstar. THE FOREGOING CONSTITUTES PALSTAR'S SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE LIABILITY FOR INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY INFRINGEMENT. This indemnity does not apply to infringements that would not be such, except for customer-supplied elements.

6. SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE

If Palstar, in its discretion, requests written verification of an error or malfunction discovered by you or requests supporting example files that exhibit the Software problem, you shall promptly provide such verification or files, by email, telecopy, or overnight mail, setting forth in reasonable detail the respects in which the Software fails to perform. You shall use reasonable efforts to cooperate in diagnosis or study of errors. Palstar may include error corrections in maintenance releases, updates, or new major releases of the Software. Palstar is not obligated to fix errors that are immaterial. Immaterial errors are those that do not significantly impact use of the Software.

Updating Software may require the updating of software not covered by this Software License Agreement before installation. Updates of the operating system and application software not specifically covered by this Software License Agreement are your responsibility and will not be provided by Palstar under this Software License Agreement. Palstar's obligations under this Section 6 are contingent upon your proper use of the Software and your compliance with the terms and conditions of this Software License Agreement at all times. Palstar shall be under no obligation to provide the above technical support if, in Palstar's opinion, the Software has failed due to the following conditions: (i) damage caused by the relocation of the software to another location or CPU; (ii) alterations, modifications or attempts to change the Software without Palstar's written approval; (iii) causes external to the Software, such as natural disasters, the failure or fluctuation of electrical power, or computer equipment failure; (iv) your failure to maintain the Software at Palstar's specified release level; or (v) use of the Software with other software without Palstar's prior written approval. It will be your sole responsibility to: (i) comply with all Palstar-specified operating and troubleshooting procedures and then notify Palstar immediately of Software malfunction and provide Palstar with complete information thereof; (ii) provide for the security of your confidential information; (iii) establish and maintain backup systems and procedures necessary to reconstruct lost or altered files, data or programs.

7. SOFTWARE ACTIVATION, UPDATES AND LICENSE METERING

(a) License Metering. Palstar has a built-in license metering module that helps you to avoid any unintentional violation of this Software License Agreement. Palstar may use your internal network for license metering between installed versions of the Software.

(b) Software Activation. Palstar's Software may use your internal network and Internet connection for the purpose of transmitting license-related data at the time of installation, registration or update to an Palstar-operated license server and validating the authenticity of the license-related data in order to protect Palstar against unlicensed or illegal use of the Software and to improve customer service. Activation is based on the exchange of license related data between your computer and the Palstar license server. You agree that Palstar may use these measures and you agree to follow any applicable requirements.

(c) Website Update. Palstar will provide a Website Update to you, which is free of charge. Palstar may use your internal network and Internet connection for the purpose of

transmitting license-related data to a Palstar-operated Website Update server to validate your license at appropriate intervals and determine if there is any update available for you.

8. TERM AND TERMINATION

This Software License Agreement may be terminated (a) by your giving Palstar written notice of termination; or (b) by Palstar, at its option, giving you written notice of termination if you commit a breach of this Software License Agreement and fail to cure such breach within ten (10) days after notice from Palstar. In addition, the Software License Agreement governing your use of a previous version that you have upgraded or updated of the Software is terminated upon your acceptance of the terms and conditions of the Software License Agreement accompanying such upgrade or update. Upon any termination of the Software License Agreement, you must cease all use of the Software that it governs, destroy all copies then in your possession or control and take such other actions as Palstar may reasonably request to ensure that no copies of the Software remain in your possession or control. The terms and conditions set forth in Sections 1(g), (h), (i), 2, 5(b), (c), 9, and 10 survive termination as applicable.

9. RESTRICTED RIGHTS NOTICE AND EXPORT RESTRICTIONS.

The Software was developed entirely at private expense and is commercial computer software provided with **RESTRICTED RIGHTS**. Use, duplication or disclosure by the U.S. Government or a U.S. Government contractor or subcontractor is subject to the restrictions set forth in this Agreement and as provided in FAR 12.211 and 12.212 (48 C.F.R. §12.211 and 12.212) or DFARS 227. 7202 (48 C.F.R. §227-7202) as applicable. Consistent with the above as applicable, Commercial Computer Software and Commercial Computer Documentation licensed to U.S. government end users only as commercial items and only with those rights as are granted to all other end users under the terms and conditions set forth in this Software License Agreement. You may not use or otherwise export or re-export the Software or Documentation except as authorized by United States law and the laws of the jurisdiction in which the Software was obtained. In particular, but without limitation, the Software or Documentation may not be exported or re-exported (i) into (or to a national or resident of) any U.S. embargoed country or (ii) to anyone on the U.S. Treasury Department's list of Specially Designated Nationals or the U.S. Department of Commerce's Table of Denial Orders. By using the Software, you represent and warrant that you are not located in, under control of, or a national or resident of any such country or on any such list.

10. GENERAL PROVISIONS

If you are located in the European Union and are using the Software in the European Union and not in the United States, then this Software License Agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States of America (excluding its conflict of laws principles and the U.N. Convention on Contracts for the

International Sale of Goods) and you expressly agree that exclusive jurisdiction for any claim or dispute with Palstar or relating in any way to your use of the Software resides in the State of Ohio, USA and you further agree and expressly consent to the exercise of personal jurisdiction in the State of Ohio, USA in connection with any such dispute or claim.

If you are located in the United States or are using the Software in the United States then this Software License Agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Ohio, USA (excluding its conflict of laws principles and the U.N. Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods) and you expressly agree that exclusive jurisdiction for any claim or dispute with Palstar or relating in any way to your use of the Software resides in the federal or state courts of Ohio and you further agree and expressly consent to the exercise of personal jurisdiction in the federal or state courts of Ohio in connection with any such dispute or claim.

If you are located outside of the European Union or the United States and are not using the Software in the United States, then this Software License Agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States of America (excluding its conflict of laws principles and the U.N. Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods) and you expressly agree that exclusive jurisdiction for any claim or dispute with Palstar or relating in any way to your use of the Software resides in the federal and/or state court of Ohio and you further agree and expressly consent to the exercise of personal jurisdiction in the federal and/or state court of Ohio in connection with any such dispute or claim. This Software License Agreement will not be governed by the conflict of law rules of any jurisdiction or the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods, the application of which is expressly excluded.

This Software License Agreement contains the entire agreement and understanding of the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof, and supersedes all prior written and oral understandings of the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof. Any notice or other communication given under this Software License Agreement shall be in writing and shall have been properly given by either of us to the other if sent by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, or by overnight courier to the address shown on Palstar's Web site for Palstar and the address shown in Palstar's records for you, or such other address as the parties may designate by notice given in the manner set forth above. This Software License Agreement will bind and inure to the benefit of the parties and our respective heirs, personal and legal representatives, affiliates, successors and permitted assigns. The failure of either of us at any time to require performance of any provision hereof shall in no manner affect such party's right at a later time to enforce the same or any other term of this Software License Agreement. This Software License Agreement may be amended only by a document in writing signed by both of us. In the event of a breach or threatened breach of this Software License Agreement by either party, the other shall have all applicable equitable as well as legal remedies. Each party is duly authorized and empowered to enter into and perform this Software License Agreement. If, for any reason, any provision of this Software License Agreement is held invalid or otherwise

unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the remainder of this Software License Agreement, and this Software License Agreement shall continue in full force and effect to the fullest extent allowed by law. The parties knowingly and expressly consent to the foregoing terms and conditions.
